Day Camp Program

- ◆ HHEC, Inc. offers a Day Camp Program for Beginning to Intermediate/Advanced Riders.
- ◆ This program will provide each student with hands-on experience learning about grooming, leading, saddling, horse care, riding (English or Western), plus a horse show for parents 2-4pm on Friday.
 - ◆ We emphasize safety, education, and having fun with one of our horses.
 - ◆ Students will be grouped by ability. ◆ This program is for ages 7-18.
- ◆ Each weeklong session is from Monday to Friday, 9am to 4pm. ◆ Maximum 10 campers per session.

CHA 1A = Beginner Rider
CHA 1B = Beginner/Intermediate Riders who have completed CHA 1A
CHA 2 = Advanced Rider



All Campers Need to Bring:

- ◆ Lunch and a drink each day.
- ◆ An ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet. HHEC has a few available for use.
- ◆ Riding boots are required. No bare feet, sandals, or sneakers are allowed.
 - ◆ Long pants, no shorts.
- ◆ Optional: Gloves with a gripping surface.
